- Know their community's needs and provide valuable feedback.
- ✓ Plan activities with the library's director and trustees, asking "what can we do," instead of announcing "we will do this."
- ✓ Raise money for materials, equipment, and projects not able to be covered by the library's operating budget.
- ✓ Sponsor cultural and educational programs to enlighten and entertain.
- ✓ Volunteer to do special library tasks and projects.
- ✓ Represent the library to the community raising public awareness, speaking to civic groups, attending council/ commission meetings, and contacting government officials to communicate the library's financial needs.
- ✓ Advocate for the library by speaking out on local, state, and national issues that affect libraries.
- ✓ Recognize exceptional performance of library staff members.
