Library Law: Changes to the library law have been approved and signed by the Governor. The new law will take effect July 1, 2017. Among other changes the law now specifies that trustees may not serve more than two consecutive terms on local and regional library boards and that library boards have line-item control over the library budget.

Standards Survey – Each year libraries are asked to complete an online report on progress toward meeting the Standards for Non-Metropolitan Libraries. The report for FY 16/17 is due July 15, 2017.

Trustee Certification Challenge Days – Beginning in July and continuing through November, on one Friday each month, the regional office will be showing all ten sessions of the Trustee Certification program in the meeting room. The sessions will start at 9:30 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m.

Regional News:

Spring Hill – Three architectural firms have been chosen to make proposals for a new library building. A public meeting with the three firms will take place May 5th.

Marshall County – The Needs Assessment has been completed. It recommends building a 40,000 sq. ft. library in Lewisburg and a 20,000 sq. ft. branch in Chapel Hill.
