Library Law Revisions: During this legislative session, <u>Tennessee Library Laws</u> have been updated. These updates will go into effect on July 1, 2017. State Librarian Chuck Sherrill has sent out a letter to local boards, library directors and city/county officials about the updated laws. If you have questions about those laws and how they will affect your library and board, please let us know.

Library Forms: We've sent out the Library Service Agreements, Maintenance of Effort Forms and Board Appointment forms. The dates for return of each form are as follows: LSA: July 28, 2017; Board Appt. Form: first board meeting of the new fiscal year; MOE: as soon as your funding body approves its 2017-2018 budget. If you have questions or concerns about the forms and dates due, please let us know.

Trustee Workshop: This year's Trustee Workshop will be held Friday, September 15, at the Art Circle Library in Crossville, TN. Trustees will receive notification and a registration form via traditional mail. As a reminder, trustee attendance at this workshop usually awards more points toward Technology Grant funding in the following year, so try to attend if at all possible.
