Maury Co. – It was determined as a result of the recent needs assessment that 16,000 titles need to be weeded from the Mount Pleasant branch.

Giles Co. – Due to the 49% increase in their annual budget the main library is now open 7 days a week. **Hickman Co.** – Library director David Dansby has been accepted into the PLMI program and begins his first week long classroom session of this program in November.
